**RESOLUTION INTRODUCING PROPOSED LOCAL LAW ENTITLED
“A LOCAL LAW TO OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN
GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW §3-c FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026”**

WHEREAS, the Town Board (the “Town Board”) of the Town of Dresden (“Town”) has the authority, pursuant to the Town Law, General Municipal Law, and Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, to adopt local laws regarding its affairs and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has reviewed its anticipated revenues and expenditures for the upcoming fiscal year and wishes to consider a local law authorizing an override of the tax levy limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c for Fiscal Year 2026; and

WHEREAS, a draft local law entitled “A Local Law to Override the Tax Levy Limit Established in General Municipal Law §3-c for Fiscal Year 2026” has been drafted and reviewed by the Town Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority vested in the Town Board in the General Municipal Law and the Municipal Home Rule Law, the Town Board wishes to proceed with the holding of a public hearing concerning the proposed local law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the proposed local law entitled “A Local Law to Override the Tax Levy Limit Established in General Municipal Law §3-c for Fiscal Year 2026” is hereby accepted for introduction to the Town Board; and be it further

RESOLVED, that a public hearing shall be scheduled for the consideration of this proposed local law to be held by the Town Board on _____, 2025 at _____.m., at the offices of the Town of Dresden; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board authorizes delivery of the local law to the members of the Town Board via email in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is directed to post and publish a notice of said public hearing in the official newspaper of the Town, and post same on the Town's website, five (5) days before the hearing; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.
