- Call the Meeting to Order
- Pledge to the Flag
- Opening Statement by Deputy Wilbur:
  - “The Purpose of this meeting is to interview the candidates for the Town Supervisor vacancy.
  - Each Candidate will introduce themselves and then the board will have an opportunity to ask questions.
  - Any appointment vote will occur back in open session.
  - To be clear, the appointment under discussion will last until December 31, 2026. A regular election for the position will be held in November during the General Election. Anyone interested in serving beyond the end of the year is strongly encouraged to file with the Board of Elections in Fort Edward.”
  
- The Format:
  - Candidate Statements- Each candidate will have 5 to 10 minutes to speak about their background, interest in the role, and thoughts about the town, done in alphabetical order.
  - Thank them for their statements. We will now move into questions from the board.
  - Board Members will then question the candidates. There may be follow-up questions based on the candidate's specific answers or background.
  - There may be allowed a brief, limited period of time to allow additional questions from the audience to cover issues not already addressed. However, this could be, if time allows, at the discretion of the Town Board.
  - All interaction with the candidates will occur in open session so the public can hear the discussion. After the interviews, the board will enter into Executive Session to deliberate about the candidates; no votes will occur in executive session. The board will return to open session for any motions and for an appointment vote, which will be public.
- At this time the board will conclude the public interview portion of the meeting and politely ask each of the candidates and the public to step outside for board discussions of the qualifications of the individuals under consideration. A motion along with a second; note the time.
- Return to Open Session. Let the record reflect that no action was taken in executive session.
- Open the floor for a motion regarding the appointment of a Town Supervisor.
- A motion, and a Second—any discussion? A roll call vote.
- Motion passes or fails. If passed, a candidate is appointed to Town Supervisor. If it fails, repeat with remaining candidates.
- The next regular Town Board Meeting will be held on April 13<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m.
