**RESOLUTION APPROVING ACTIONS OF TOWN BOARD MEMBERS
ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN OF DRESDEN**

WHEREAS, the Town Supervisor of the Town of Dresden resigned in February of 2026, followed by the resignations of two (2) Town Board members, with such resignations leaving the Town Board of the Town of Dresden with less than a quorum necessary to officially conduct Town Board business; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding such resignations, the business of the Town of Dresden was required to continue, and Deputy Supervisor and Town Board member Allen Wilbur, and Town Board member Marilyn Borden, undertook significant and meaningful actions to ensure that the employees of the Town of Dresden remained paid, and that the bills and other obligations of the Town of Dresden continued; and

WHEREAS, many of the actions of Deputy Supervisor and Town Board member Allen Wilbur, and Town Board member Marilyn Borden were necessarily required to be taken without official vote of the Town Board due to lack of quorum of the Town Board; and

WHEREAS, the entirety of the Town Board, including Town Supervisor, have now been duly appointed, both by the actions of New York Governor Kathy Hochul, and the new majority of the Town Board; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board as now lawfully constituted, wishes to thank Deputy Supervisor and Town Board member Allen Wilbur, and Town Board member Marilyn Borden for their actions during the lack of quorum of the Town Board, and approve their actions taken, and to thank Governor Hochul for appointing a member of the Town Board so that the official business of the Town of Dresden could resume.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that Town Board approves of all actions taken by Deputy Supervisor and Town Board member Allen Wilbur, and Town Board member Marilyn Borden in furtherance and continuation of the official business of the Town of Dresden, with significant thanks for their hard work and dedication to the residents and taxpayers of the Town of Dresden; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board thanks Governor Kathy Hochul for her actions in appointing a member to the Town Board so that a proper majority and quorum of the Town Board could once again be officially constituted, and so that the official business of the Town of Dresden could resume; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.
